English Teacher – Seed Center

OVERVIEW

The Seed Center aims to build strong, healthy communities through education and practical support of migrant workers and their families within Chiang Mai. At Seed we train and empower young people to make a positive difference for their people and their community. The English Teacher's role is to work with the Head Teacher to provide quality English lessons and form good relationships with the students. The English Teacher reports to the Head Teacher and comes under the Social Development Department.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

1. To teach English through the English program at Seed. This will sometimes include leading the class and other times be assisting the Head Teacher
2. To do lesson planning for each English class you lead following the curriculum set by the Head Teacher
3. To work alongside the Head Teacher and other short term staff to create a positive learning experience
4. To meet at least fortnightly with the Head Teacher to discuss how English class is going as well as any issues that come up
5. To write short blogs and updates for use on the Partners Facebook and web page
6. Other ad hoc tasks as assigned by the Head Teacher or Department Head
7. To maintain good communication with the Seed staff including discussing lesson plans, letting them know if you will be late and getting their feedback on how the students are doing. This should include meeting at least weekly with the Seed Staff
8. Commit to living out the core values in line with Partners' mission and vision statements

KEY ATTRIBUTES

The person filling this position is expected to speak, write, and read English fluently, have the ability to teach in front of a large group, have a servant's heart, be spiritually resilient, demonstrate patience, have a flexible and team player attitude, and be willing to work within a Christian framework while being sensitive to various religious expressions across cultures and denominations. Some teaching experience is helpful but not required.

NOTE:

The person filling this position is to be based in Chiang Mai in Thailand. This is a full-time position. All short and long-term staff are expected to cover their own travel and living costs, as there is no stipend or salary available for this role.
